Types of Data Collected

Among the Personal Data collected by this site, either independently or through third parties, there are: Cookies, IP address.

Full details on each type of data collected are provided in the dedicated sections of this privacy policy or through specific information texts displayed before the data is collected.

The Personal Data may be freely provided by the User or, in the case of Usage Data, collected automatically during the use of this site.

Unless otherwise specified, all the Data requested by this site are mandatory.

If the User does not communicate them, it may be impossible for this site to provide the Service. In the event that this site indicates some Data as optional, Users are free to refrain from communicating such Data, without this having any consequence on the availability of the Service or on its operation.

Users who have doubts about which data are required are encouraged to contact the owner.

Any use of Cookies - or other tracking tools - by this site or third-party owners used by this site, unless otherwise stated, is intended to provide the Service requested by the User, in addition to the additional purposes described in this document and in the Cookie Policy.

The User assumes the responsibility of the Personal Data of third parties obtained, published or shared through this site and guarantees to have the right to communicate or disseminate them, freeing the Owner from any responsibility towards third parties.

Mode and place of processing of the collected Data

Treatment modalities

The Data Controller uses appropriate security measures to prevent unauthorized access, disclosure, modification or destruction of Personal Data.

Processing is carried out using IT and / or telematic means, with organizational methods and logic strictly related to the purposes indicated. In addition to the Owner, in some cases, other parties involved in the organization of this site (administrative, commercial, legal, system administrators) or external parties (such as third party technical service providers, postal couriers, hosting providers, computer companies, communication agencies) also appointed, if necessary, Data Processors by the Owner. The updated list of data processors may always be requested from the Data Controller.

Legal basis of the processing

The Owner processes Personal Data relating to the User if one of the following conditions exists:

the processing is necessary for the execution of a contract with the User and / or for the execution of pre-contractual measures;

processing is necessary to fulfill a legal obligation to which the Owner is subject;

the processing is necessary for the pursuit of the legitimate interest of the Data Controller or third parties.

It is in any case always possible to ask the Owner to clarify the concrete legal basis of each treatment and in particular to specify whether the treatment is based on the law, provided for by a contract or necessary to conclude a contract.

Place

Hosting servers are located outside the European Union. For more information, contact the owner.

The User's Personal Data may be transferred to a country other than the one in which the User is located. To obtain further information on the place of treatment, the User can refer to the section concerning the details on the processing of Personal Data.

Period of conservation

The Data is processed and stored for the time required for the purposes for which it was collected.

Purposes of the processing of the collected data

The User Data is collected to allow the Owner to provide its Services, as well as for the following purposes: Statistics, Contacting the User and Displaying content from external platforms.

To obtain further detailed information on the purposes of the processing and on the Personal Data that are specifically relevant for each purpose, the User may refer to the relevant sections of this document.

Details on the processing of Personal Data

Personal Data is collected for the following purposes and using the following services:

- Contact the user
- Statistics
- Display of content from external platforms

In detail, Personal Data may be collected for the purposes indicated using one or more of the following services: In the event that a service of this type is installed, it is possible that, even if the Users do not use the service, the same collect data of traffic related to the pages in which it is installed.

Google Fonts (Google)

Google Fonts is a font style visualization service managed by Google Inc. that allows the site to integrate such content within its pages.

Google Maps widget (Google) Google Maps is a map viewing service managed by Google Inc. that allows the site to integrate such content within its pages.

SPAM protection

This site uses an AntiSpam service, which analyzes traffic, potentially containing Users' Personal Data, in order to filter it from parts of traffic, messages and contents recognized as SPAM.

System log and maintenance

For needs related to operation and maintenance, the site and any third party services it uses may collect system logs, that is files that record the interactions and that may also contain Personal Data, such as the User IP address.

User Rights

Users can exercise certain rights with reference to the Data processed by the Owner.

In particular, the User has the right to:

- withdraw consent at any time. The User can revoke the consent to the processing of his Personal Data previously expressed.
- object to the processing of your data. You may object to the processing of your data when it takes place on a legal basis other than consent. Further details on the opposition right are indicated in the section below.
- access their own Data. The User has the right to obtain information on the Data processed by the Owner, on certain aspects of the processing and to receive a copy of the Data processed.
- verify and request the adjustment. The User can verify the correctness of his / her Data and request its updating or correction.
- obtain the treatment limitation. When certain conditions are met, the User may request the limitation of the processing of his / her Data. In this case, the Owner will not process the Data for any other purpose than their storage.
- obtain the cancellation or removal of your Personal Data. When certain conditions are met, the User can request the deletion of their Data by the Owner.

- receive your data or have it transferred to another owner. The User has the right to receive his / her Data in structured format, commonly used and readable by an automatic device and, where technically feasible, to obtain its transfer without obstacles to another holder. This provision is applicable when the Data is processed by automated tools and the processing is based on the consent of the User, on a contract of which the User is a party or on contractual measures connected to it.
- make a complaint. The User can propose a complaint to the competent personal data protection supervisory authority or act in court.

Specific information on the right to object

When Personal Data is processed in the public interest, in the exercise of public authority over which the Data Controller is invested or to pursue a legitimate interest of the Data Controller, Users have the right to oppose the processing for reasons connected to their particular situation.

Users are reminded that, if their Data are processed for direct marketing purposes, they may oppose the processing without giving any reasons. To find out if the Data Controller treats data for direct marketing purposes, Users can refer to the respective sections of this document.

Extended Cookie Policy Policy

We use cookies to make our site easier and more intuitive. The data collected through cookies is used to make the browsing experience more enjoyable and more efficient in the future.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files sent by the site to the terminal of the interested party (usually to the browser), where they are stored before being re-transmitted to the site on the next visit by the same user. A cookie cannot retrieve any other data from the user's hard drive or transmit computer viruses or acquire e-mail addresses. Each cookie is unique to the user's web browser. Some of the cookie functions can be delegated to other technologies. In this document the term "cookies" refers to both cookies, properly so called, and to all similar technologies.

Type of cookies

Cookies can be first or third party, where "first part" means cookies that report the site as a domain, while "third party" means cookies that relate to external domains.

Third-party cookies are necessarily installed by an external party, always defined as a "third party", not managed by the site. These parties may also install first-party cookies, saving their own cookies on the site's domain.

Another type of cookie are the so-called "Flash Cookies" (Local Shared Objects), used within Adobe Flash Player to deliver some content, such as video clips or animations, in order to remember settings and preferences. Flash cookies are stored on the device, but are managed through a different interface than the one provided by the browser used.

Nature of cookies

Regarding the nature of cookies, there are different types:

Technical cookies

Technical cookies are those used for the sole purpose of "transmitting a communication over an electronic communication network, or as strictly necessary for the provider of an information society service explicitly requested by the subscriber or user to provide this service "(see Article 122, paragraph 1 of the Code).

They are not used for other purposes and are normally installed directly by the website owner or manager. They can be divided into:

- browsing or session cookies, which guarantee the normal navigation and use of the website (allowing, for example, to make a purchase or authenticate to access restricted areas); they are in fact necessary for the proper functioning of the site;

- analytics cookies, similar to technical cookies when used directly by the site manager to collect information, in aggregate form, on the number of users and how they visit the site, in order to improve the site's performance;
- functionality cookies, which allow the user to browse according to a series of selected criteria (for example, the language, the products selected for purchase) in order to improve the service rendered to the same. For the installation of these cookies, the prior consent of the user is not required (more information in the paragraph on cookie management below).

Profiling cookies

Profiling cookies are aimed at creating user profiles and are used to send advertising messages in line with the preferences shown by the user in the context of web browsing.

The use of profiling cookies requires the consent of the interested party. According to the provision (more information in the paragraph on cookie management below) the user can authorize or deny consent to the installation of cookies through the options provided in the "Manage cookies" section.

In the case of third-party cookies, the site does not have direct control of individual cookies and cannot control them (it can neither install them directly nor delete them). You can still manage these cookies through your browser settings (follow the instructions below), or the sites listed in the "Manage cookies" section.
